All nominees must submit their written acceptance of the nomination along with their curriculum vitae (CV)/resume and credentials.

Nomination documents are accepted in writing only via email, mail, delivery service, or fax and must be received by September 25, 2025. This deadline is based on the bylaws and the business calendar.
